

Allowing Popup instructions for <https://sa.ku.edu> for Internet Explorer/Firefox/Chrome/Edge

Some of the following instructions allow for pop-ups from all sites. When encountering a pop-up from a particular site, you should be given a dialog box to allow pop-up from that particular site.

Internet Explorer for PC

1. Go to Internet Explorer menu, select Tools.
2. Click on Popup Blocker.
3. Click on Popup Blocker settings.
4. In the 'Address of web site to allow:' textbox, type <https://sa.ku.edu> and click Add.
5. Click the Close button to close the Pop-up Blocker Settings window.

Firefox for PC

1. Go to Firefox menu (upper right-hand corner), Options.
2. Click on Content.
3. Under Content, the Block Popup Windows should be checked.
Click the Exceptions button.
4. In the "Address of web site" box, type <https://sa.ku.edu> and click on the Allow Button and then click on the Save Changes button
5. Close the Options window.

Google Chrome for PC

1. Click the Chrome menu on the browser toolbar.
2. Select Settings.
3. Click Show Advanced Settings.
4. In the "Privacy" section, click on the Content settings button.
5. In the "Pop-ups" section, click on the Manage exceptions button.
6. Type in <https://sa.ku.edu>, select Allow and click on the Done button.
7. Close Chrome settings window.

Microsoft Edge for PC (This Disables Pop-Ups for All Sites)

1. Click the three-dotted More Actions, then click Settings within the dropdown menu.
2. Scroll down to Advanced Settings, then click View Advanced Settings.
3. Under Block Pop-ups slide the setting to Off.

Firefox for Mac

1. Go to the Firefox menu (upper right-hand corner), Preferences.
2. Click on Content.
3. Under Content, the Block Popup Windows should be checked.
Click the Exceptions button.
4. In the "Address of web site" box, type <https://sa.ku.edu> and click on the Allow Button and then click on the Save Changes button.
5. Close the Options window.

Safari for Mac

1. In the top left of the browser window, click Safari.
2. Click Preferences.
3. Click Security tab found on the front row.
4. Under Web Content, uncheck Block Pop-Up Windows.

Safari under IOS 10.2

1. Under Settings, select Safari.
2. Under the General area, switch the Block Pop-Ups to off.
3. Should switch Block Pop-Ups back on when finished.
